

## Using siproxd to allow VoIP through a firewall

Session Initiation Protocol (SIP) is a popular open standard for implementing telephone calls. Siproxd is a SIP proxy server that can help you with network firewalls. One major reason that you might use siproxd is to get around network firewalls. Siproxd can run on a firewall machine that is directly connected to the Internet. Clients on the intranet behind the firewall can then connect to siproxd.
