

Building a glossier front end for MythTV

Josh Stewart loves MythTV -- so much so that he is building his own front-end for MythTV's default. The replacement is called Gloss, and although it isn't ready for production, OpenGL effects and GStreamer bindings show plenty of promise. One of MythTV's most useful applications is that the front end (through which you watch television) and the recorder (DVR) applications (which runs the scheduling database and records video to disk) are separate and connect to the same back end independently.
