

Sun VP Quits over Open-Source Java Move

Graham Hamilton - Sun Fellow and VP, has left the company over the decision to move Java to open source. Hamilton has been with Sun since 1995, and has contributed to a wide variety of Java technologies such as CORBA support, the JDBC APIs, JavaBeans, the Java Plug-in, RMI-IIOP, and the Java Swing API. He acted as the specification lead for J2SE releases 1.3 and 1.4. He has helped with the Java API development and he was one of the designers of the Java Community Process.
